



May Week 1

Teacher Activity A: Hoop Tag 1

Equipment

5 hoops for every 15 children

<i>Set Up</i>	Lay out four hoops to make a giant square, about 10 feet apart, with the 5 th hoop in the middle of the square.
<i>Trans-In</i>	2 children are It. They stand in middle hoop, other children in corner hoops.
<i>Intro Qs</i>	Do you think you can run fast? Do you think you can get from your hoop to another hoop without being tagged?
<i>Explain The Game: When I say GO!</i>	When the teacher says GO, children will run from one hoop to another hoop while the It children try to tag them. If tagged, a child will go to the sidelines and do 5 jumping jacks, then return to play. The children who are It must return to the center hoop once all the other children are safe in hoops. Repeat with new taggers.
<i>Trans-Out</i>	Return hoops to storage container.
<i>Change Up</i>	Increase the challenge by playing outside and making the square bigger.



May Week 1

Teacher Activity B: Number Jumping

Equipment

2 sets of number cards (download from website)

Painters tape

<i>Set Up</i>	Tape down number cards about 4 inches apart, with the numbers in random order.
<i>Trans-In</i>	Children line up to have a turn. If you have a big group, use several sets of numbers.
<i>Intro Qs</i>	Do you think you can jump from number to number in order?
<i>Explain The Game: When I say GO!</i>	Taking turns, children will jump, 2 feet to 2 feet, from number to number in order, calling out the numbers as they go. Each child can have several turns.
<i>Trans-Out</i>	Collect the number cards.
<i>Change Up</i>	For older children, have them add an amount to each number. If they add 3, when they jump to 1, they say 4. For younger children, line the numbers up in order and have them say the number as they jump on it.
