## Teacher Activity A: Hoop Tag 2

## Equipment

2 hoops for every 15 children

A smooth floor – wood, linoleum, low pile carpet

<i>Set Up</i>	None
<i>Trans-In</i>	2 children are It. They each have hoops. The rest of children are in Starting Position.
<i>Intro Qs</i>	Do you think it is possible to kick this hoop across the room? Can you avoid getting hit by it?
<i>Explain The Game: When I say GO!</i>	The It children stand in the middle of the room with their hoops flat on the floor. The other children run around the room in the same direction. The It children kick the hoops and try to tag the running children's feet. If tagged, the tagged child goes to the side, does 5 jumping jacks, and returns to the game.
<i>Trans-Out</i>	Return hoops to storage container and children return to the Starting Position.
<i>Change Up</i>	For younger children, the teacher is It.

## Teacher Activity B: Scarf Juggling

## Equipment

1 scarf per child

<i>Set Up`</i>	Throw scarves all over the floor.
<i>Trans-In</i>	Children are in the Starting Position.
<i>Intro Qs</i>	Can you catch a scarf before it hits the ground?
<i>Explain The Game: When I say GO!</i>	Each child gets 1 scarf and tries throwing and catching it. Try: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• throw/catch with their favorite hand</li> <li>• throw/catch with other hand</li> <li>• throw with one hand, catch with other</li> <li>• throw and clap as many times as they can before they catch it.</li> <li>• throw it up, spin around, catch it</li> <li>• move it around waist in each direction</li> <li>• pass it between legs in figure 8 and switch direction</li> </ul>
<i>Trans-Out</i>	Collect the scarves.
<i>Change Up</i>	For younger children: They hold one corner and move the scarf around in many directions. For older children: juggle 2 scarves.
